CONTACT CONSENT FORM

If you haven't heard about GDPR yet, it stands for General Data Protection Regulation. It is an attempt by the EU to modernise existing data protection laws, bringing them into line with the many different ways personal data is stored and used in the 21st century (and it will still apply in the UK even after Brexit). So, that means new regulations concerning how businesses can use personal data, promising greater levels of protection and additional rights for individuals.

WHO DOES GDPR APPLY TO?

The regulation will effectively apply to any businesses holding personal data of EU citizens, and that includes things like names, email addresses, bank details, photos, identification numbers, medical information and even information like IP addresses and social media posts.

WHAT PROTECTION DOES IT PROVIDE?

Businesses will be required to safeguard the personal data they hold on individuals, to ensure that it does not fall into the hands of unauthorised third parties. And crucially, in addition to the safeguarding of personal data, businesses will need to ensure they have consent from their customers before they can send marketing activity to them. Consent must be kept in a secure place. Moreover, from this point forward consent must be positively given. Another important development is that members will have the right to withdraw their consent at any time, and they will also have the right to be forgotten. That means businesses will need to know exactly where the personal information of all their customers is held, because they will have to permanently delete it if requested to do so.

WHAT DOES ALL THIS MEAN TO ME?

After GDPR comes into effect your personal data held by various businesses should be more secure, and you should also have more control over it. Capel St Mary Allotments Association uses the services of a 3rd party mailing organisation to send email communications to our members (currently this is MailChimp)

We would like to send you the following information relating to your membership of the association by email

- Membership related information
- Details of events that the association is organising
- Regular newsletters with association and gardening related information

All of our emails contains 2 links, one a link whereby you can opt-in or opt-out of specific types of email by updating your profile. Secondly a link where should you decide you no longer want to receive emails from the association you can unsubscribe completely.
